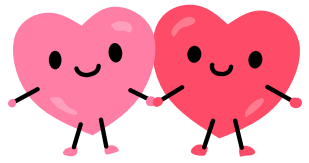
BRINGING ADVANCED DIAGNOSTIC CARE TO ST KITTS & NEVIS



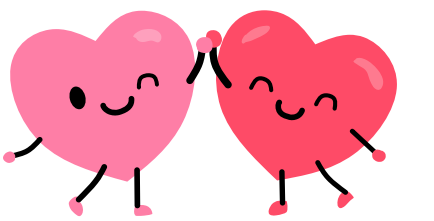
PALS is committed to improving access to advanced pediatric care to the Federation of St. Kitts & Nevis. In June, PALS hosted our second annual telehealth conference with World Pediatric Orthopedic Surgeon Dr. Lindley Wall with support from St. Kitts Orthopedic Surgeon, Dr. Duane Hendrickson. This virtual clinic was attended by 15 children with mobility issues with upper extremities (finger, hand, arm, elbow, shoulder) and provided our PALS children the opportunity to benefit from specialized diagnostic care without the travel.

In November 2025, PALS sponsored two medical professionals from St. Kitts and Nevis to attend advanced Pediatric Echocardiogram Training in St. Vincent. Dr. Caroline Lawrence and ultrasound technician, Mrs. Ava Spencer joined other regional practitioners for this intensive course led by a team of top pediatric cardiologists and echocardiogram specialists with World Pediatric.

In this new world of innovative medical technology, PALS remains committed to finding solutions for our children to access advanced pediatric care not readily available in the Federation.

D'Nique is doing so well but still requires follow up visits and further treatment in the near future.





Spotlight on our PALS Children



HAZIEK: 10 years old, Barracuda Bite

In September 2024, when Haziak from St. Kitts was only nine years old, he sustained severe injuries to his left arm from what was first suspected to be a shark bite (but later confirmed a barracuda bite) while swimming in shallow waters at the beach. The extensive damage to his arm required overseas medical treatment. Haziak was transferred to the Bones & Joints Surgery Clinic in Trinidad where he underwent his first round of surgeries and wound treatment to save his arm.

But this was just the beginning of a long road of treatment for Haziak. In 2025, Haziak has bravely endured three months of surgeries and extensive post-care treatment at Shriner's Hospital in St. Louis. Haziak has been so strong through this difficult process and as an avid basketball fan, he remains hopeful that he will regain full use of his arm in the future.



J'Cardie: 2 years old, Neurosurgery



Two year old J'Cardie has the brightest smile that makes him such a joy to be around. Even through his neurosurgery and plastic surgeries at the Children's Hospital New Orleans for a complex neurological condition, little J'Cardie was pure sunshine.

Thankfully, his surgeries and six week stay for post surgical treatment were a success and little J'Cardie returned to St. Kitts more active and happier than ever and he requires no further treatment moving forward.

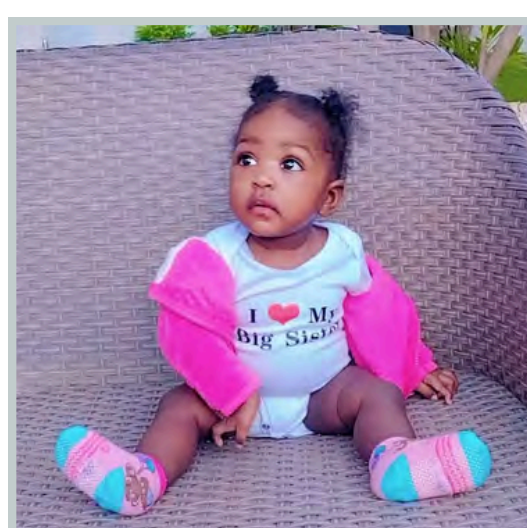


PRINCE: 10 years old, Blount's Disease



10 year old Prince from St. Kitts was accepted by World Pediatric for treatment at Shriner's Hospital in St. Louis for surgery on his legs due to Blount's Disease, a medical condition found in children that affects the growth plates around the knee. In 2025, Prince spent three long months at Shriner's Hospital for extensive surgeries and physical therapy. Since he was little, Prince's condition greatly affected his quality of life and limited his ability to run and play with his friends. But the surgery was a success and Prince is currently back in St. Kitts continuing with physical therapy. He will require a minor follow up procedure in 2026 but Prince is expected to recover fully with no further issues moving forward.

LIAHANNA: 1 year old Nerve Reconstruction Surgery



Little Liahanna was born with arm and shoulder issues as a result of complications during her birth.

The PALS family was so grateful when World Pediatric and Shriner's Hospital for Children in Philadelphia accepted one year old Liahanna to treat her Right Brachial Plexus injury. In 2025, Liahanna spent five weeks at Shriner's Hospital in Philadelphia for right nerve reconstruction surgery and extensive post surgery physical therapy. Liahanna and her mom also enjoyed staying with a host family during their time in Philadelphia who provided them amazing support and kindness during this difficult time.

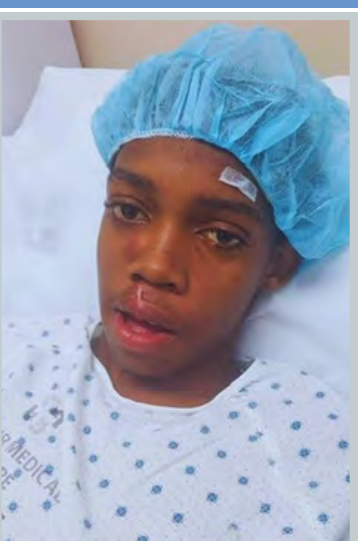
